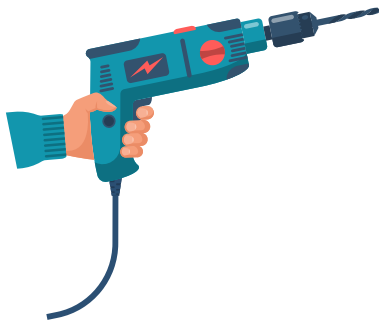


Safety Basics for Powered Hand Tools

Do

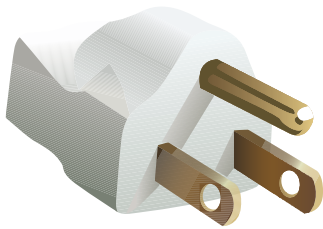


Choose Well

- Right for the job
- Fits your hand
- Well-maintained
- No frayed cords or missing parts

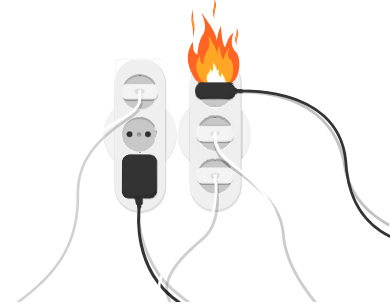


Don't



Power Safely

- No daisy chains or overloaded circuits
- Unplug when not in use
- Use the correct battery



Use Safely

- Tether tool when working at heights
- Use both hands when possible
- Secure item being worked upon



Protect Yourself

- Vision
- Hearing
- Hands
- Lungs
- Head



Protect Others

- Communicate
- Restrict access when working



Store Safely

- Tag out if defective
- Secure items
- Unplug
