Key Findings

- Employee engagement in safety and health was the most commonly reported priority and the most commonly reported challenge to improvement
- Leadership engagement was reported as a crucial factor in driving safety culture and employee engagement
- A Values-Driven leadership approach was associated with the highest levels of employee engagement
- Incorporating Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) principles into safety practices remains a growing area of focus
