Montgomery County PD piloted novel technology to count violations

August - November Distracted Driving Study

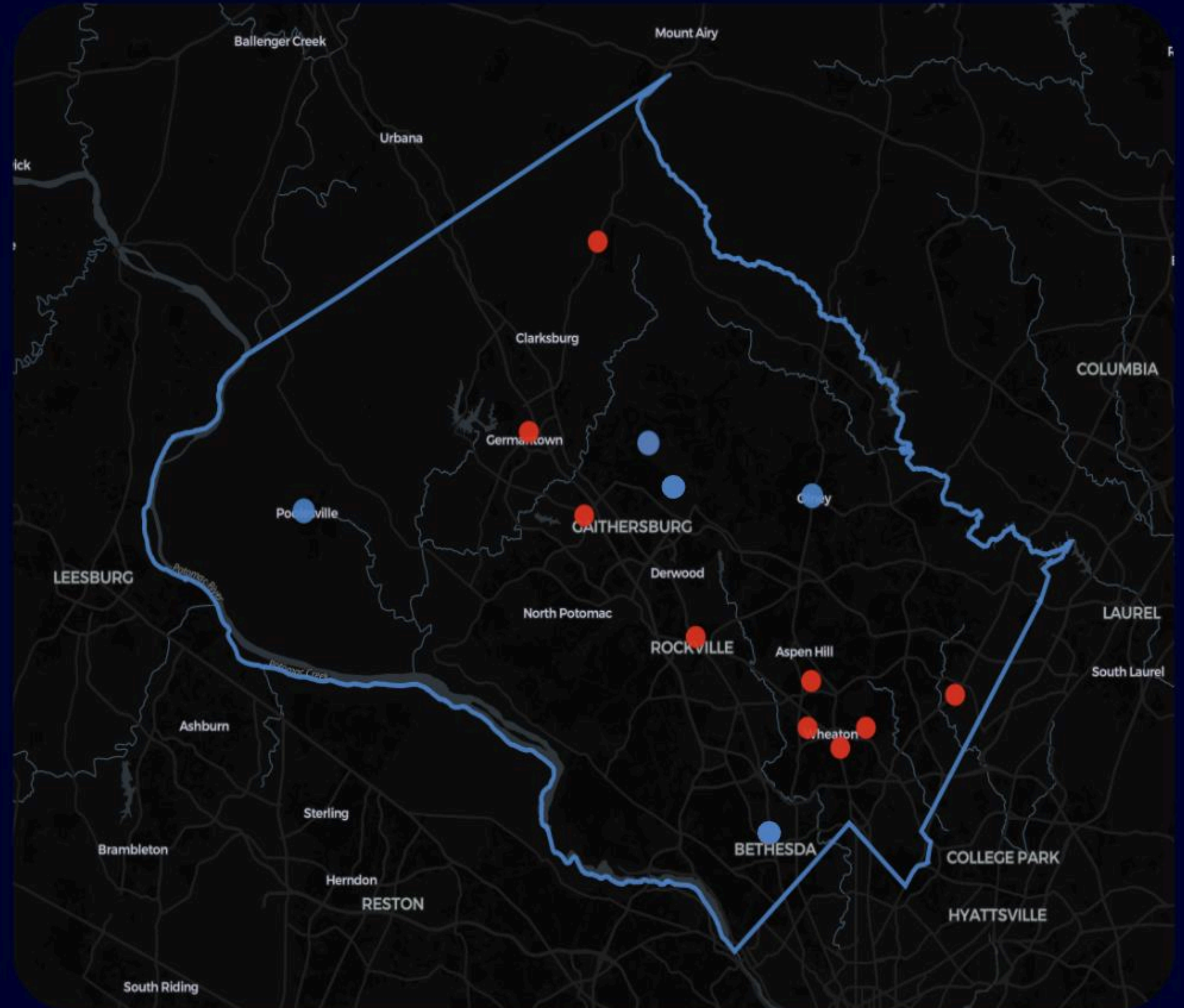
- 14 locations (9 done, 5 planned), placed equitably around Montgomery County
- Gathered evidence & statistics of distracted driving
- Demonstrated privacy-preserving features & helped quantify extent of problem



Montgomery County Pilot Study

2,500

violations per day estimated
across **9 locations**
20% of all vehicles daily



In Montgomery County: Legislators considered automated enforcement legislation
